

**TOWN OF HAMPTON**

**BY-LAW # 170-05**

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND HIGHWAY BY-LAW NO. 113-92**

The Council of the Town of Hampton under the authority vested in it, by Section 7 of the *Municipalities Act*, amends By-law #113-92 and enacts as follows –

SECTION 36 is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

No person shall park a motor vehicle on any street or sidewalk in anyway from the 1st day of November in any year until the 1st day of May in every succeeding year, from 12 o'clock midnight to 7 o'clock in the morning: any vehicle so parked shall be deemed a public nuisance.

When a by-law enforcement officer or peace officer finds a vehicle parked in violation of this part, he may attach to the vehicle a notice to the owner or operator of thereof that the vehicle is parked in violation of this part and informing the owner or operator that he may pay a voluntary penalty in the amount of \$10.00, within twenty (20) days of the time when such notice was attached to vehicle to the Town of Hampton. The sum of \$10.00, together with the notice or its number, when received by the Town of Hampton shall be a voluntary penalty for and in full satisfaction of the violation.

Upon failure of such owner or operator to make the foregoing payment within twenty (20) days, the owner or operator shall become liable to a fine of a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50) to a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500) per offence, with a fine of fifty dollars (\$50) for a first offence, a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100) for a second offence, a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200) for a third offence, a fine of four hundred (\$400) for a fourth offence, and a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for all subsequent offences.

Where a vehicle is parked or left standing on the street and in such a manner that it interferes with or obstructs snow removal operations, a peace officer or a Public Works Department Employee may cause such vehicle to be moved or towed. In such case, the owner shall, in addition to any other penalty, pay the cost of such removal and storage of such vehicle.
