BY-LAW 193-11

A BY-LAW RESPECTING DANGEROUS OR UNSIGHTLY PREMISES


Pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 190 of the *Municipalities Act*, Chapter M-22, RSNB, 1973 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Hampton, duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. Section 190.001 to 190.07 of the *Municipalities Act*, including any amendments thereto, apply to the whole area within the limits of the municipality.
2.
 - (a) Village of Hampton By-law No. 26 Respecting Dangerous or Unsightly Premises, enacted on the 12th day of June 1979, and amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
 - (b) The repeal of By-law No. 26 shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.


