BY-LAW NO. 145-00

CUREFW BY-LAW.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAMPTON, UNDER AUTHORITY VESTED IN IT BY THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT, SECTION 95 HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS

1. In this By-law
(1) 'child' means a person 16 years or less;
(2) 'adult' means a person 19 years or older;
(3) 'peace officer' means
(a) a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
(b) any member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police auxiliary while on duty.

CUREFW

2. No child shall be in a place other than a designated residence in the Town of Hampton on Sundays to Thursdays between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following day, and on Fridays and Saturdays between the hours of 11:59 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following day, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or adult family member.
3. Any child who violates section (2) of this by-law may be ordered by any peace officer to go home. In the event of neglect or refusal by the child to go home as ordered, the child may be taken into the peace officer's custody.
4. A parent or guardian who permits his or her child to violate any provision of this by-law commits an offense punishable under Part 11 of the *Provincial Offences Procedure Act* as a category B offence.
5. This by-law comes into effect on the date of filing in the Registry Office.
