**Asbestos** - Asbestos presents a potential lung disease hazard when released into the air. It is present in thousands of common building materials used prior to the early 1990's, and is still used today in some applications. Prior to demolition or alteration activities, owners & contractors are responsible to ensure that asbestos and asbestos type materials (ACM;s) are removed from the area that is being altered or demolished.
