Please read before performing any burning

Burning brush or yard debris:

Permits for the burning of brush during the forest fire burn season are valid based on the Dept. of Natural Resources Burning Permit Information Line. This service is available typically from the beginning of April until the end of October. If you have obtained a permit outside this burn season, please call Hampton Fire-Rescue - Fire Prevention Division at (506) 650-8517. If there is no answer, please leave a message for when you intend to burn.

Burning permits are required within the Town of Hampton during the entire year.

During the forest fire burn season, you must call Natural Resources at 1-866-458-8080 (toll free) to determine the burning conditions for Kings County **every day prior to any burning.**

If burning is permitted in Kings County, then burning will also be permitted within the Town of Hampton.

If burning is restricted (burning allowed from 8:00pm to 8:00am), then burning in the Town of Hampton will also be restricted to these times.

If burning is not permitted (Kings County is closed), then no burning is permitted within the Town of Hampton.

The Natural Resources forecast is updated daily and is valid from 2:00pm till 2:00pm the following day.

Brush permits will be issued for a period of 7 days only and renewals must be obtained through the Fire Prevention Division of Hampton Fire - Rescue by calling (506) 650-8517 (if no answer, please leave message).

Any fires found unattended by any member of Hampton Fire - Rescue shall be extinguished and the permit revoked at the discretion of Hampton Fire - Rescue.

Burning permit policies:

- Brush piles shall be no bigger than 3 metres in diameter (10ft) and no higher than 2 metres (6.5ft).
- A minimum clearance of 10 metres (30ft) shall be observed from any property line.
- A minimum clearance of 4.5 metres (15ft) shall be observed from any combustible structure or trees.
- A responsible person shall be present at all times of burning.
- A garden hose and shovel or rake shall also be available to prevent the spread of fire.

Acceptable items for burning include:

- Brush
- Clean scrap lumber
- General yard clean-up performed
